

PRIVACY STATEMENT OF THE GLOBAL-STUDENT SCHOOL COOPERATION

1. The purpose of data processing

This statement is intended to lay down the general principles of data processing used and the special data protection measures taken by the Global-Student School Cooperation for its website www.globalstudent.hu

This statement contains the rules and regulations of handling personal data in respect of the services provided within the website and in case of any data processing during the period of membership / task completion. By using the services provided by the website, users also agree to the conditions set in this statement.

2. The legal basis of data processing, scope of data collected

The handling and processing of your personal data (especially the personal data registered in the Membership Agreement and the Declaration of Admission signed by you, furthermore all data generated during your membership) is performed with your prior and explicit voluntary consent in compliance with the relevant articles of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

The scope of personal data collected:

- a. Name, e-mail, telephone number, gender, place and date of birth, educational level, nationality, place of residence, mailing address, main occupation, professional experience gained in this field, languages spoken, photograph, CV, including list of qualifications and previous work experience, driving license, ownership of a vehicle, ID number, motivational letter, preferred time of working, type of occupation you are interested in).
- b. In respect of the contribution made as a member of the school cooperation: student card number, its expiration date, the date of its presentation to the regionally responsible Data Handling Officer, Social Security number, highest level of education, bank account number, medical certificates in case they are required.)
- c. In respect of the contribution made as a member of the school cooperation during fulfilling the given tasks: place, starting and end date of completing tasks, which office you are registered to, date of entry, start and end date of contract, amount of membership fee, payment method of membership fee, description of task to be fulfilled, amount of compensation to be paid, personal data (height, weight, shoe size) relevant in case of wearing protective working outfit.

3. Identity of data processor, purpose of data collection, transfer of data

The Global-Student Iskolaszövetkezet (registered office: 67-81. Pesti Street, C Building, 5th Floor - Apt. 25, Budapest, 1173, company registration number:01-02-054565, tax number: 26574404-2-42), hereinafter referred to as the Data Processor, collects and handles your personal data for the purpose of completing its administrative, HR and Controlling tasks (e.g. calculation of compensation to be paid, preparation of Social Security statements.)

The Data Processor is entitled to forward your personal data to a Third Party (hereinafter referred to as the Provider of Services) for data processing in respect of the tasks to be completed within the framework of the Membership Agreement.

4. Duration of data processing

The data processing will be performed until explicit withdrawal of your consent. You – except for the data processing based on the current legislation – can request the deletion of your personal data; in case of such request the Data Processor will delete your data within 30 working days after the receipt of request. In case the processing of your personal data is performed with your prior consent, the Data Processor is entitled to handle your data for the purpose of fulfilling a legal obligation or in order to ensure the interest of the Data Processor or Third Party, even after your consent was revoked.

The Data Processor – except for the data processing based on the current legislation – will delete your personal data three years after their recordings.

5. Persons eligible to gain access to personal data handled

Within the organization of the Data Processor those persons will gain access to your personal data who are obliged to assist the fulfillment of the purpose of the data collection.

6. Consequences of failure to provide personal data

Data are collected on a voluntary basis.

In case the member fails to provide the obligatory data needed upon admission, he cannot be registered. Failure to provide the non-obligatory data will not influence the success of admission, but are needed latest upon signing the Admission of Membership.

7. Rights, rights of appeal

The member (whose personal data is collected by the Data Processor) has the right to:

- a. ask information about the processing of his personal data,
- b. request access to his personal data,
- c. request correction of his data,
- d. request deletion of his data,
- e. request the limitation of processing his personal data (Article 18, GDPR),
- f. perform his right for portability of his personal data. (Receiving his personal data in form of word or excel file and / or these files to be transferred to another data processor.)
- g. to file a complaint to the relevant authorities.

In case of violation of your rights, you can turn to the court of justice.

You can file a complaint at the Hungarian National Authority for Data Protection.
